

# Publication Fee Request

## For GIA Projects Awarded prior to 2022

**Purpose** | The Graduate Medical Education (GME) and Research Advisory Committee through the Prisma Health Midlands Foundation understands the increased occurrence of manuscript publication fees required by publishers. This notice allows the reallocation of previously awarded funds to be used for publication fees, originally considered a non-allowable project expense, to assist in the dissemination of the Grant In Aid project results.

**Eligibility** | Any Grant In Aid awardee with an open project (e.g., a final report has not been submitted). The project must have been awarded prior to 2022.

**Funding Amount** | If funds remain in the requested project budget, the awardee may reallocate the funding up to \$1,000 to be used for publication fees for manuscripts based on the Grant In Aid awarded project. No additional funds will be allotted to the awardee/project.

**Access Publication Fees** | Send a request via email to Dr. Marigliano indicating the manuscript title, the journal where the manuscript will be submitted, the publication fee amount, and how the current budget will be reallocated to include the publication fee. If the publication fee is greater than \$1,000, the expense must be covered personally or by the home department. The payment of the publication fee will follow the normal funding process set forth by the Grant In Aid program.

**Expectations** | It is expected that once the publication fee has been funded and the project results are published that the project will be closed via a final report. The final report should include "a copy of the end result of the project", and the publication should satisfy this requirement and be the culmination of the awardee's efforts.
