Prisma Health's Greenville Memorial Hospital is the region's premier referral center for Upstate South Carolina. The hospital, located in rapidly growing Greenville, is home to a 24-hour Level I Trauma Center, along with the Upstate's only pediatric trauma center. The surrounding campus houses many of the area's top specialty programs and educational facilities that train the next generation of caregivers. Since our hospital's inception in 1912, our highest priority has been to provide patients with compassionate, exceptional, leading-edge care.
