Details:

- \$1000 reimbursement towards the costs of travel and housing
- Four-week clinical rotation in one of our available Dept. of Pediatrics Visiting Student Catalog
- Residency interview with Prisma Health / USCSOM Greenville Pediatric Residency
- Inclusion in resident educational conferences, simulation center training, and activities
- Opportunities to network with resident and faculty leaders based on student interest
 (eg. subspecialty/fellowship, advocacy, immigrant and global health, medical education)

Eligibility:

- Must be in good standing in a LCME or AOA accredited school intending to pursue pediatric residency
- Must have completed a Pediatric core clerkship and successfully passed USMLE Step 1
- Identify as belonging to a group that is underrepresented in medicine as defined by the AAMC including but not limited to African Americans and/or Black, Hispanic/Latino, Native American (American Indians, Alaska Natives, and Native Hawaiians), Pacific Islander, and mainland Puerto Rican.

Application:

- Statement of declaration that you meet the eligibility requirements
- Brief letter of interest (less than one page) which may include reasons for interest in our program or this rotation, ties to the region, and/or career goals.
- Academic Transcript (unofficial transcripts acceptable) and Curriculum Vitae
- Application decisions will occur on a rolling basis starting June 15th. We encourage you to complete your application as early as possible to receive full consideration.
- If selected, applicants will need to complete formal application through VSLO.
