Prisma Health Orthopedics Athletic Training Residency Program The Prisma Health Orthopedics Athletic Training Residency Program, formerly Palmetto Health USC Orthopedics, provides athletic trainers a broad clinical experience within 12 months (54 weeks). Athletic training residents start in June and conclude the following June. Residents rotate among surgeons, non-operative physicians and other healthcare professionals during their 12 months of residency.

Our rotations are one-on-one mentorshipbased, preceptor-led, educational experiences with physicians and other healthcare



professionals. Residents participate in patient care in the office and field settings, performing physical examinations and assisting in surgery.

Residents are responsible for appropriate decision-making in terms of the patient/athlete problem and the algorithmic approach to patient/athlete care. They abide by the operating room skills curriculum and learn operating room skills. The program provides a multifaceted learning experience in musculoskeletal evaluation and injury diagnosis so that residents can lead in their fields of endeavor – clinical, surgical, educational or research.



Admissions

Prisma Health Orthopedics offers an Athletic Training Residency Program for certified athletic trainers. The purpose of our residency program is to enable athletic trainers to expand their knowledge in musculoskeletal evaluation and diagnosis as athletic trainers in the orthopedic office, to further their education in all aspects of sports medicine, and to be prepared to excel in a variety of settings.
