Course Objectives:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Perform at the level of a beginning first year resident. 2. Perform and dictate an admission History and Physical. 3. Follow and have primary responsibility for the care of the patients they admit (from admission through discharge). 4. Work with the hospital healthcare team to transition the patient safely back to the outpatient setting. 5. Demonstrate the ability to order appropriate diagnostic studies and interpret their results. 6. Demonstrate a working knowledge of common outpatient medical problems and develop an understanding of the conditions requiring inpatient treatment. 7. Demonstrate the ability to assess the psychosocial aspects of a patient’s history and the effects they might have on the health of the patient.
Course Description:	<p>This course offers an intensive experience at an academic family site practicing broad scope family medicine. During this rotation students will be placed in a variety of clinical environments to best obtain a diversified experience which may include hospital care of the newborn, obstetrics, and care of the acutely hospitalized patient to primary care for pediatrics, women’s health, adults, and geriatric patients. USC students will follow the longitudinal checklist and USC and Visiting students will plan to participate in residency activities (eg QI projects and Journal Club) and perform primary care procedures (eg joint injections and pap smears). Students will spend approximately half of their time inpatient at Greenville General Memorial on FMTS with 1 weekend day shift, and half of their</p>

time outpatient at a Center for Family Medicine (CFM) Residency Clinic. The weekend shift will be determined by the academic site to give additional experience for extended continuity, conducting admissions, or responding to critical events. The call shift will need to follow duty hours as outlined by the student handbook.
