

URIM Away Rotation Scholarship 2023

OB/GYN Acting Internship Prisma Health, University of South Carolina School of Medicine—Greenville Greenville, South Carolina

Program Description:

The Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology at Prisma Health in Greenville, SC is pleased to offer a scholarship-funded away rotation for up to two students who are from racial/ethnic groups that have been historically excluded and are underrepresented in medicine (URiM).

Program Goals and Rationale:

To provide the highest quality patient care and best environment for physician training, we seek to recruit and retain a diverse group of physicians at the resident and faculty levels. Data are clear that this diversity leads to better patient outcomes and more effective healthcare teams. As such, we hope to provide broader exposure to our residency training program among URIM medical students by providing a scholarship to lessen financial barriers to completing an away rotation.

Rotation Details:

Selected students will complete a 4-week Acting Internship in one of these areas: Maternal-Fetal Medicine (MFM), Reproductive Endocrinology and Infertility (REI), or Female Pelvic Medicine and Reconstructive Surgery (FPMRS/Urogynecology). The AI will include 1. daily rounding and patient care Monday through Friday each week, and 2. one 24-hour Saturday call shift.

Scholarship Details:

Selected students will be provided with a \$2000 stipend to help cover costs associated with travel, lodging, and meals during their away rotation.

Eligibility:

Students must live outside of Upstate South Carolina (>50-mile radius from Greenville Memorial Hospital) and must meet the rotation requirements listed on the VSLO site.

How to apply:

Interested students must apply for the general visiting student rotation through the VSLO® system and must meet eligibility requirements there. They must also complete the scholarship application, including a brief Statement of Interest, by clicking the link below.

Application Timeline:

Application deadline is May 1, 2023. Applicants who have been selected for the scholarship will be notified by May 15, 2023.
