

Clinical Pastoral Education Program

CPE SUMMER INTERN PROGRAM (10-12 Positions Available; 1 unit of CPE upon completion)

The Intern program is an eleven week, full-time intense program of study primarily designed to introduce seminary students to the clinical method of learning and to provide an opportunity to complement their theological studies with the practice of ministry. Interns are assigned as chaplain interns within the various placements available through Prisma Health. There they gain hands-on experiences that facilitate reflection in pastoral identity formation and development and pastoral theology. Interns also participate in the on-call rotation for overnight and weekend duty.

CPE RESIDENCY PROGRAM (12 Positions Available; 4 units of CPE upon completion)

The residency year is divided into four of CPE, each with a distinct curriculum focusing on the learning needs of the peer group. Residents rotate through a variety of clinical placements. They are given input into clinical placements, supervisory assignments and seminar design as the year progresses. Residents participate in the on-call rotation serving as the on-site chaplain on call during nights and weekends.

CPE EXTENDED PROGRAM (6 Positions Available; 1 unit of CPE upon completion)

The Extended CPE program is designed for lay leaders and ordained clergy who desire additional theological training connected to their present ministry and vocational setting. This program is designed for parish ministers (pastors, ministers of music, youth, children, etc.) and lay leaders involved in voluntary or paid leadership positions. It is also open to parish nurses, social workers, teachers or others who want to reflect theologically about their particular call. The unit lasts 15-20 weeks with students meeting together one or two days/week for educational seminars with the option of completing field education hours in their local parish.
